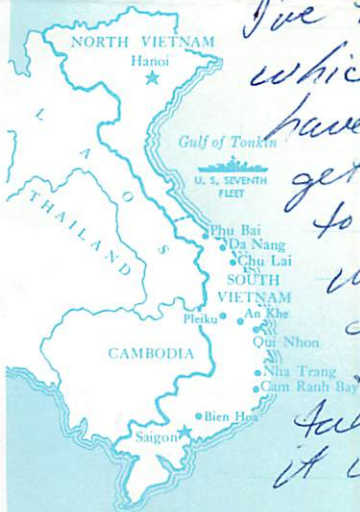
Dear Mom & Dad,
